BENEFICIAL OWNERSHIP REPORTING

Beginning January 1, 2024, businesses must report information about their beneficial owners — the persons who ultimately own or control the company — to the U.S. Department of Treasury's Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN) under the Corporate Transparency Act passed by Congress in 2021. This is part of the U.S. government's efforts to make it harder for bad actors to hide or benefit from illicit activities, while minimizing the burden on entities doing business in the United States.
